


## UQ Global Connect Scholarship

Scholarship under UQ Global Connect Scheme

- A 25% tuition fee reduction is available for TKU students who commence an approved credit transfer pathway at The University of Queensland for the duration of their UQ studies
- You will still need to cover your OSHC, your visa, expenses
- No need to apply but students shall be included in the TKU provided commencement student list each semester. Scholarship offer will be sent to the students to accept.
- Scholarship will be applied around orientation and after students complete enrolment

^ students must be international students, meet UQ program entry requirements, not hold any other UQ scholarship and agree to the scholarship terms and conditions

## FAQ: Do I need to complete the specified 4 courses before applying for this dual degree program?

The passing of the specified four courses are for credit transfer to UQ relevant Master degree so as to shorten the student's study at UQ and save tuition fees but these courses are not for entry to the UQ degree.

- o These courses are not deemed to satisfy the entry to the degree.
- o If the students fail or don't study those courses, they still can apply for our Master program but need to meet our Master degree entry regardless.
- O But they can't transfer the credit for those courses they haven't studied or completed, that means they will need to study them in UQ and lengthen their UQ degree to longer than 1 year.

# FAQ: Can I apply for this Dual Masters if I don't come from the relevant discipline background



Yes, certainly you can apply. There are two following options.

## 1. 1 + 1.5 option:

Apply for UQ standard 2-year relevant Master program (course list <u>here</u>) for any background students. But it's likely that the student needs to study 1.5 years instead of 1 year at UQ because compared to 1.5 years reduced duration UQ Master program, the student needs to study more foundational courses (e.g. three more such courses in MBus, four in MIntEcon&F) unless eight courses (up to 1 year maximum) can match UQ Master program.

## 2. 2 + 1 option:

O Graduate first from TKU Master degree first (e.g. MBA) and use this Master to meet the relevant discipline requirement for the reduced duration UQ Master program. This way it becomes 2+1 arrangement.

## FAQ: Are there internship opportunities with companies in Australia?



### There are many internship opportunities, yet it's not automatically given.

- O UQ and BEL Faculty have many initiatives to boost their employability during their study at UQ. Further details please refer to the UQ Fast Facts document and our Faculty's Careers and Employability website <a href="https://bel.uq.edu.au/for-students/careers">https://bel.uq.edu.au/for-students/careers</a>
- If you have a student visa, you can work:
  - up to 48 hours per fortnight (2-week period) during university semesters, and
  - full-time hours during vacations.
- O This 1+1 doesn't meet the current post study work visa requirement. I suggest the student talk to the UQ Union visa officer (<a href="https://uqu.com.au/student-advocacy-and-support/">https://uqu.com.au/student-advocacy-and-support/</a>) or approved migration agents for more advice on work visa or immigration.



# FAQ: Is there medical insurance coverage while studying at UQ?

Yes, all international students studying on a student visa must have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).
